States of Matter

In Year 4, we did a science experiment about states of matter. The children observed a balloon filling up with Carbon Dioxide gas after they mixed vinegar and baking soda. They also watched a bath bomb disintegrate and create bubbles and then researched the science behind this phenomenon. They learnt about the different properties of solids, gas and liquid and how materials change phases.







Walk Like an Egyptian

This term, Year 3 is working on Ancient Egypt. One of the projects is to create an Ancient Egypt 3D visual map, working in teams. The children are learning the difference between 2D and 3D, boosting their imagination, and creativity as they improve their visual skills and enjoy the activity. The children have learned a lot about Ancient Egypt, they started to understand why The Nile River was so important 6000 years ago and learned about some of the most famous monuments, such as the Pyramids at Giza and the mythical Sphinx. Students are using materials such as clay, cardboard, and colour pencils . They have divided the map into 4 quadrants where each team will focus on their own work, and put it all together at the end of the activity. A big round of applause for Year 3!



















All About Capacity

In Year 5, we explored the capacity of different containers. The children were reminded of the units and made estimates. They were provided with measuring jugs and measuring cylinders, and I was impressed by their ability to read scales with different calibrations.

This week we have been working on creating different props that we will use, including binoculars to help us locate 'different'.
